- 4) Rates should be quoted strictly for the item specified in the list and for standard quality of goods. ## Teaching CPR Resusci Baby with indicator and practicing baby with metronome

The teaching manikin should have following feature

Must have realistic anatomy including head tilt, chin lift, compression depth, compression force and chest rise

Must Resemble a less than a year-old Infant Baby

Must have sensor to indicate correct hand placement

Must have ventilation system which provides appropriate chest rise withBVM (Bag Valve Mask) and MTM (Mouth to Mouth)

Must have enhanced feedback devices which should be touch enabled and generates a Comprehensive feedback of the Quality of the CPR.

The Mannequin should be able to connect to the feedback device.

Should be operable by both Battery and External power inlet.

Must have sensors to recognize depth, release and rate of the compressions

Must have sensors to recognize the volume and rate of ventilation

The practising manikin should have following feature.

Manikins provided should be for complete CPR training purpose.

Adult, Child and Infant models manikins should be provided as per 2015 CPR guidelines.

Realistic looking and performing manikin should be acceptable to both instructors and students

It should be easier and faster to carry and setup at training sites

Face/head tilt should simulate how an actual victims head would move if he required CPR and teaches students how to properly open the airway.

It should have feature where head should fall back to neutral position one the hands are released, showing complete similarity of human anatomy.

Easily inserted face-shield/ lung-bag should provide visual chest rise to ensure students receive the most accurate and realistic training

Face shield should be secured so it should not slip and there should be no need for adhesives.

All model asked, should be with Blue CPR Rate Feedback Monitor. The monitor batteries should be very easy to install in manikin.

Blue CPR Rate Feedback Manikin should display different light as per the rate of compression Per minute.

CPR Rate Monitor should show instant feedback to both instructor and student regarding the rate of chest compression, allowing each student to gauge their rate of compressions on their own as well as allowing the instructor to monitor several students quickly and easily.

The manikin should have unique clicker mechanism which provides an audible conformation when the correct compression depth is reached. This increases student confidence by guiding to the appropriate force when administering CPR compressions.

Clamshell torso opening should allow for quick and easy lung bag insertion and removal

Manikins should not be made with natural rubber latex

Direction for use and instruction manual should be provided for easy references.

Must be compliant with the latest guidelines for CPR.
